

B-SOC 180 (pulled)

Luis Guerrero expressed concern for the new SOC 180 Statistics course being proposed. He reiterated his understanding that this is a statistics course with a social justice lens. Although this course is a good model for a DEI perspective, Luis expressed concern about the lack of an institutional

philosophy for statistics course offerings. He presented data from other colleges who offer discipline specific statistics courses. He expressed concern about how a statistics course with a lower unit value could potentially affect the existing courses. Jack recommended this item go to the GE subcommittee in order to further discuss student needs and decide how best to handle this and other statistics courses. Ben explained that the creation of this course satisfies a needed transfer option for Sociology students at Cal State San Marcos. This course will be limited in its offering and targeted specifically toward Sociology majors. Luis's offered a suggestion to add a letter "J" to the course number as a solution to delineate the Social Justice Statistics course from other statistics courses. He suggested that there also could be accreditation concerns with the difference in units.

### F. DISCUSSION

1. Ethnic Studies Requirement/Multicultural Requirement (MSC Dixon, Guerrero)

A recommendation was made by the GE Subcommittee to replace the college's Multicultural Studies requirement for the Associates Degree with the CSU Ethnic Studies Requirement. The recommendation was unanimous. The arguments were:

- **A.**Student Focus streamlining requirement will reduce unit creep (students taking more classes than they need financial aid implications)
- **B.** Ethnic Studies Requirement and outcomes will serve our students in a way that the MC requirement does not
- **C.** Faculty expertise minimum qualifications
- **D**.All of our curriculum should include DEI content.

Current multicultural courses will not be deleted but will not be a local requirement for the Associate's Degree. The CSU requires students to take an approved Ethnics Studies course. Palomar will align with this model for students to meet local Associate Degree requirements. This has been approved statewide so Palomar's adoption would align with the state's decision.
