- ◆ META contains all official Palomar College Course Outlines of Record
- ◆ Course Outlines of Record are accessible without a Palomar College META user account and password
- ◆ Only Full-Time Faculty may originate curriculum proposals
- ◆ All Curriculum is created, edited and approved within the META Database

META Reports

- ◆ Course Outline—Official COR for the course
- ◆ Course Impact—Shows which programs/courses a course impacts
- ◆ Comparison—Highlights changes made to the course or program,
- ◆ All Fields—Shows all COR fields plus additional course information such as DE, codes, validations, etc.
- ◆ Program—Courses in a program (A.A., A.S., A.A.-T, A.S.-T, Cert.)

A Course Change allows you to change catalog and student records:

- ◆ Catalog Course Descriptions
- ◆ Components and Hours
- ◆ Unit Value
- ◆ Course Numbers and Titles
- ◆ Course Discipline
- ◆ Requisites (add, delete or edit)
- ◆ Textbooks (at least one no older than 5 yrs.)
- ◆ Course Content
- ◆ Distance Education (add, edit, delete)
- ◆ Cross-Listings
- ◆ Any other course content

A Course Review allows you to change (no effects to catalog/student records):

- ◆ Course Content
- ◆ Course Objectives
- ◆ Student Learning Outcomes (SLOs)
- ◆ Requisite Validation
- ◆ Add or Remove Distance Education
- ◆ Assignments
- ◆ Methods of Instruction/Assessment
- ◆ Textbooks/Resources (at least one no older than 5 years)

To Create a Course/Program Curriculum Proposal in META (New, Review, Change, Review/Add DE, Deactivation, Reactivation, etc.):

Log in → “Create Proposal” → “Select Proposal Type from Dropdown” → Next → Enter Minimum Course/Program Requirements (Subject, Number, Title, Description) → Next → Create Proposal → Complete Pages → Launch

To Take Action on a Proposal in META:

Log in → “Approvals” → Click Course → Use “Course/Program Proposal” or “Reports” to Evaluate → Select “Action” from the dropdown → Select Date → Enter Comments (optional) → Click “Commit”

To Review Comments or Determine the Status of a Proposal in Curriqūnet:

Log in → “Approvals” → Click Course → All Actions/Approvers/Comments appear below (most recent actions appear at the top of the list)
