6 Instructors validated to teach online over the summer. 121 total to date.

### Canvas Pilot:

Shells were made available for both Canvas and BB, so instructors could experiment with them and select the one they wanted to publish to their students without any other special arrangements.

18 Instructors agreed to be in the Canvas Pilot 2, with 35 courses, which were a combination of hybrid, online, and f2f. There are 13 more Canvas courses made available to students by instructors not participating in the pilot. Total: 48 courses in Canvas.
