### II. 2012-2013 Projects:

#### • Application for EEO Advisory Committee

## Diversity Event

The committee had a discussion regarding two potential theme ideas:

o Unity & Diversity of Religions and Beliefs

o Cultivating Awareness of Cultural Traditions

It was agreed by consensus the theme will be: *Cultural Convergence: Acculturation, Reinvention and/or Creation.* Committee members were asked to bring names of possible keynote speakers and panelists to the December meeting. Charles Ingham volunteered to speak with Performing Arts faculty about entertainment.

#### • Input to SSPC for Online Student Orientation Programs

Sub-committee members provided topic suggestions for student orientations. Diane McAllister clarified there are two orientations. Students view a 20-minute orientation after they take Math and English assessments. She said it would be beneficial to students if a 30-second script on the prevention and consequences of sexual harassment could be incorporated into the orientation. Charles Ingham volunteered to speak with Performing Arts faculty about the script. The deadline for providing this training to SSPC is November 30, 2012. Diane said the second orientation is a two-hour online program and a five to seven minute script could be included. It was suggested that information for the online orientation could be excerpted from current training provided by Keenan & Associates. Another suggestion was to ask Keenan to create training specifically for students. Scripts will need to be reviewed and approved by the EEO Committee.
