Readings will include texts by:

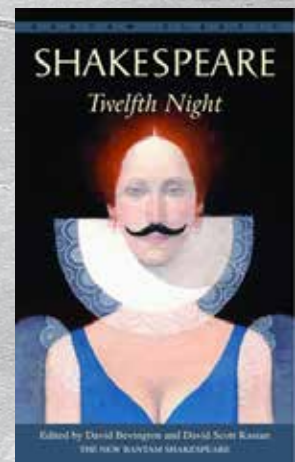
Geoffrey Chaucer
