Administrative Procedures for Implementation of Pass/No Pass Policy

If you would like to change your grading option from a letter grade (A, B, C, D, F) to **Pass /No Pass (P/NP)**, or vice versa, you may do so up to the last day of instruction for the class.

The fee for a Pass/No Pass class is the same as the enrollment fee.

No faculty signature needed. However, students are advised that four-year schools may limit the number of P units acceptable for transfer. Major preparatory classes should never be taken on a P/NP basis. ENG 100, 202 and 203 may not be taken as P/NP. In most cases, courses numbered below 100 are ideally suited for the P/NP option.
