


1. Click the Financial Aid drop-down for additional information

Step 1) Login to MyPalomar Student Login

Step 5) Complete the application and submit it.


Step 6) Your Promise Checklist will appear along with your current status. Complete any outstanding items on your Promise Checklist.

Palomar College is now accepting Palomar Promise applications for the 2023-2024 school year. The Palomar Promise is designed to provide **First-Time College Students** with access to an affordable higher education and to increase college-going and completion rates in our community.

The Promise program provides up to two years of free tuition (up to 19 units per fall & spring semester), textbook assistance and access to specialized academic and career planning with related support services.

All interested eligible applicants should complete the application. Applications will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis dependent upon availability of funds. However, submitting an application does not automatically guarantee that you will be awarded Promise funding.
