CTZN 900: Citizenship
Noncredit course

This is a citizenship class for non-native speakers of English. Students learn about U.S. history and civics, culture, and community services. The class includes speaking and writing practice to help students pass the oral and written test to become United States Citizens.

Students will learn to: understand sections of the INS N-400 and answer written and oral questions about the history and government of the U.S.

At the end of the course, students will be able to:

- ✓ Write responses to 25 sample history and civics questions taken from the U.S. Naturalization test.
- ✓ Demonstrate the skills needed to pass the writing portion of the U.S. Naturalization test.
