

ENGLISH AS A SECOND LANGUAGE OTHER ESL CLASSES

ESL 20/NESL 920: Academic Listening/Speaking Credit or noncredit course

This is a class in academic English speaking and listening skills for college and formal work environments. Students study academic vocabulary, speaking strategies such as presentation techniques, and listening strategies including notetaking.

Students speak: in a variety of formal and informal personal and academic speaking situations including discussions, debates, conversations, and presentations

At the end of the course, students will be able to:

- ✓ Organize and give an individual presentation incorporating research and visual aids.
- ✓ Take notes on a simplified lecture and effectively use their notes to answer questions based on the lecture.
