Cottey College

- Four-year and two-year programs are offered at this fully accredited women's college located in Nevada, Missouri, just south of Kansas City
- Scholarships are offered through Cottey and local and state P.E.O. chapters



Educational Loan Fund (ELF)

- High school graduate or equivalent
- Citizen or legal permanent resident of the U.S. or Canada
- Enrolled in accredited U.S. or Canadian school and within two years of completing course of study
- Must be recommended by a P.E.O. chapter



International Peace Scholarship Fund (IPS)

- Must be a graduate student or student attending Cottey College from a country other than the U.S. or Canada



Program for Continuing Education (PCE)

- One time grant-in-aid for students with financial need
- Citizen or legal permanent resident of the U.S. or Canada
- Is enrolled in an educational program leading to employment or job advancement
- Must have spent at least 24 consecutive months as a non-student sometime in her adult life and be within 24 consecutive months of completing her educational goal
- Sponsored by a P.E.O. chapter



P.E.O. Scholar Awards (PSA)

- Merit-based awards for women pursuing doctoral level degrees at an accredited U.S. or Canadian college or university
- Enrolled full time with one to two full years of academic work remaining at the time of the award
- U.S. or Canadian citizen or legal permanent resident nominated by a local P.E.O. chapter



STAR Scholarship (STAR)

- Graduating high school senior and citizen or legal permanent resident of the U.S. or Canada
- Must attend an accredited post-secondary educational institution in the U.S. or Canada, full- or part-time in the academic year following high school graduation
- Recommended by a P.E.O. chapter
