DESCRIPTION AND EXAMPLES OF WASTE	<ul> <li>Approximately 99% of all Rx waste will be placed in this container.</li> <li>Antibiotics</li> <li>Tylenol</li> <li>Aspirin</li> <li>Lotions, creams or ointments (capped or in recloseable clear bag)</li> <li>Tablets, capsules</li> <li>Rx samples</li> <li>P-Listed Acutely Hazardous</li> <li>Waste (PBKC) - examples:</li> <li>Nicotine / Nicotrol</li> <li>Coumadin / Warfarin</li> <li>Place full, partial and empty packaging/ containers and excess medication into a 1.5 quart P-Listed container.</li> <li>Bulk Chemotherapy Waste</li> <li>Vials, Syringes, Ampoules</li> <li>IV bags and tubing</li> <li>Saturated gloves, gowns &amp; wipes</li> </ul>	Incompatible Rx wastes – including Aerosols, Corrosives, Oxidizers and Lab Pack must be packaged and shipped in separate hazardous waste containers per EPA and US DOT regulations. Aerosols/Flammable (SP) - examples: • Albuterol • Hurricane Spray • Tinactin Corrosives (SPC) - examples: • Pyridoxine HCL • Hydrochloric acid Oxidizers (SPO) - examples: • Potassium Permanganate • Unused Silver Nitrate Lab Pack - example: • Botox	IV solutions without Rx medication instilled that may be disposed of down the drain include: • Potassium chloride • Potassium phosphate • Sodium phosphate • Calcium • Sodium Bicarbonate • Dextrose • Saline	Chemotherapy containers that have NO observable content remaining in the container and, PPE that is not saturated, are considered "TRACE". • Empty Vial • Empty Syringe • Gown • Gloves • Goggles • Wipes • Empty IV / Tubing NOTE: Any chemotherapy container that has observable content or saturated PPE is considered BULK – see Hazardous Rx Waste.	<ul> <li>Needles</li> <li>Empty Syringes</li> <li>Ampoules</li> <li>Other infectious wastes that are not hazardous</li> </ul> EMPTY SHARPS PERMITTED
