#### IV. Fiscal Year 2014-15 Budget Information/Discussion

#### A. 2014-15 State Budget Update

Phyllis Laderman discussed the Governor's May Revise with the committee. The most significant change for PCCD, from the January budget proposal, is the allocation of one-time funds for Physical Plant and Instructional Equipment. The state has proposed reducing the allocation to include maintenance only with no match in 2014-15.

## B. 2014-15 Fiscal Budget Development Update

Phyllis Laderman informed the committee that the 2014-15 Fiscal Budget Development is on schedule. The college continues the trend of deficit spending. VP Perez and Ms. Laderman will be attending the ACBO conference next week and they will learn more details about the 2014-15 budget details.

## C. Quarterly 311 Report

The 311Q will be presented to the Board this evening. The percentage of budget expended is as expected for the third quarter. The capital outlay expenses will be moved to the Capital Outlay fund prior to close of FY 2013-14. The ending balance is still projected at approximately \$10.6\$ million.
