I. Approval of Minutes:

A. State Apportionment Review

Carmen Coniglio gave a PowerPoint presentation and provided a detailed review of the following topics:

- Overview of the funding model
- Hold harmless provision
- Student centered funding formula (SCFF)

Discussions followed the presentation and Carmen answered questions. She reminded everyone that the numbers will change as the Chancellor's Office continues to recalculate our apportionment. More information will be available after the May Revise. Jack Kahn commented on the importance of ramping up the programs for incarcerated students, high school partnerships, and non-credit courses that serve our career and technical programs.

Adrianne Lee gave an update on the Palomar Promise Program. There was a discussion regarding various opportunities that might help to improve student success. For example, there are still many students lacking a formal education plan. Many other students (across the state), need more help to achieve passing grades in math.

Adrianne also talked about the multiple changes that have been made in the Financial Aid Department to better serve our students.

- Process for granting financial aid to veterans has been streamlined.
- Institutional barriers have been removed.
- Terms for academic progress reports were changed from a semester term to an annual term.
- Policies have been changed to help re-entry students.
- The appeal process has been changed to be more flexible.
- Changes have been made in Evaluations.
- Forms have been updated.
- Staff duties have been reorganized.
- Community partnerships have been created.
- Dispersement schedules have been changed.
