

## HONORARY ASSOCIATE IN HUMANE ARTS DEGREE

## **RECOMMENDATION FORM**

The Palomar College Governing Board will rely on recommendations from the Palomar College Foundation to select the recipient(s) of honorary Associate in Humane Arts Degrees. (Palomar Community College District Policy BP 4110.) The honorary degree is selective and given to an individual who is not a student but who has done something of importance. The recipient(s) will be individuals who have made distinguished contributions to the community, to education, and/or to society.

The selection committee will determine further consideration of the candidate(s) based on information submitted on the recommendation form. If moved forward, the Governing Board shall nominate the recipient(s) in a resolution that appears as a Board meeting agenda item (March board meeting). This award is presented at the Palomar College annual commencement ceremonies in May.

Alumni, faculty, staff, and community members are encouraged to nominate candidates by submitting the completed recommendation form by February 28. Additional supporting documentation is encouraged and may be submitted in addition to the recommendation form.
