**Sunset Crater – Grand Canyon – Zion – Bryce – Capitol Reef – Canyonlands – Arches – Dinosaur**

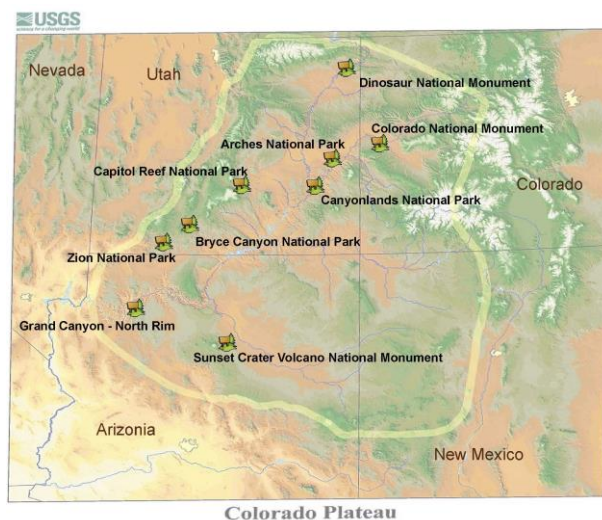
This field course will focus on the geologic processes that shape the Colorado Plateau region. Topics will include:

- Colorado River system
- Erosional landforms
- Fossil & Mineral resources
- Igneous & Volcanic history
- Stratigraphy & Paleogeography

The class will begin at Sunset Crater, AZ and will conclude in Dinosaur National Monument, UT. Several hikes are planned.

Students must arrange their own transportation; carpooling is required. A trip fee of \$100 includes reserved campsites for 8 nights. Other expenses (gas, park entry fees, meals, and incidentals) will be shared by students. The trip fee must be paid to the Cashier's Office before a permission code for enrollment can be obtained.
