BP 4100 GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS FOR DEGREES AND CERTIFICATES

The District grants the degrees of Associate in Arts and Associate in Science as well as the Associate in Arts for transfer and Associate in Science for transfer (AA-T/AS-T) degree to those students who have completed the subject requirements for graduation and who have maintained or exceeded a 2.0 grade point average in subjects attempted. Students working towards the Associate in Arts or Associate in Science must also complete the general education, residency and competency requirements set forth in Title 5 regulations. Students working towards the Associate Degree for Transfer (AA-T/AS-T) must also complete specified general education and major requirements set forth in Senate Bill 1440.

Students may be awarded Certificates upon successful completion of applicable coursework designed as a pattern of learning experiences that develop certain capabilities that may be oriented to career or general education.

The Superintendent/President shall establish procedures to determine degree and certificate requirements that include appropriate involvement of the Curriculum Committee. The procedures shall assure that graduation requirements are published in the District's catalog and included in other resources that are convenient for students.
