BP 4232 PASS/NO PASS GRADING OPTION

Courses listed in the Palomar College Catalog may be taken pass/no pass unless otherwise indicated in the Course Outline of Record. Students must make the decision to take a class on a pass/no pass basis by the end of the fourth week or the first thirty percent (30%) of a course length, whichever is less, after which no other evaluative grade may be given. Students may repeat a course previously taken for an evaluative grade on a pass/no pass grading basis. A student who earns a P upon repetition may petition for grade adjustment if the previous grade was a D, F, or FW.

A grade of P is awarded for work equivalent to A, B, or C. Courses for which a grade of P is awarded may not be used to satisfy requirements for the student's major. NP is awarded for work equivalent to D or F. Neither P nor NP is used in computing the grade point average at Palomar College; however, P/NP units appear on the transcript of record.

Units attempted for which NP is recorded shall be considered in probation and dismissal procedures.
