BP 5015 RESIDENCE DETERMINATION

Education Code Sections 68040, and 76140; Title 5 Sections 54000 et seq.

A residence classification of either resident or nonresident shall be made for each student, at the time of each application for admission and whenever a student has not been in attendance for more than one semester. A student seeking to enroll exclusively in career development and college preparation courses, and other courses for which no credit is given, shall not be subject to this residency classification requirement.

A resident is a student who has been physically present in the state for more than one year prior to the residence determination date and has demonstrated clear intent to make California a permanent home.

A nonresident is a student who does not have residence in the state for more than one year immediately preceding the residence determination date.

The residence determination date is that date immediately preceding the opening day of instruction of the semester during which the student proposes to attend the college. Enrollments in late starting classes within a term are subject to this uniform residence determination date. Each term only has one residence determination date.

A student previously classified as a nonresident may request to be reclassified.

The Superintendent/ President shall enact procedures to assure that residence determinations are made in accordance with Education Code and Title 5 regulations.
