**BP 5140 DISABLED STUDENT PROGRAMS AND SERVICES (DSPS)/
DISABILITY RESOURCE CENTER (DRC)**

Education Code Sections 67310 and 84850;
Title 5 Sections 56000 et seq.

Students with disabilities shall be reasonably accommodated pursuant to federal and state requirements in all applicable programs in the District.

Disabled Student Programs and Services (DSPS)/Disability Resource Center (DRC) shall be the primary provider for academic adjustments, auxiliary aids, services, and/or supplemental instruction that facilitates equal educational opportunities for students with disabilities who can profit from instruction as required by federal and state laws.

DSPS/DRC services shall be available to students with verified disabilities; participation is voluntary. The services to be provided include, but are not limited to, reasonable accommodations, academic adjustments, electronic and information technology accessibility, accessible facilities, equipment, instructional programs, disability management counseling, and academic counseling.

Students who seek accommodations outside of the DRC may contact the District's 504 officer.

The District shall respond in a timely manner to accommodation requests involving academic adjustments. The Superintendent/President shall establish a procedure to implement this policy which, at a minimum, provides for an individualized review of each such request, and permits interim decisions on such requests pending final resolution by the appropriate administrator or designee.

The Superintendent/President shall assure that the DSPS/DRC conforms to all requirements established by the relevant law and regulations.
