BP 5210 COMMUNICABLE DISEASE - STUDENTS

Education Code Section 76403;

The Superintendent/President shall establish procedures necessary to assure cooperation with local public health officials in measures necessary for the prevention and control of certain communicable diseases in students.

To be on campus for any face-to-face instructional and ancillary activities (e.g., office hours, classes, library, tutoring, student services, ASG, student clubs, etc.), the District may require students to be fully vaccinated, including any boosters, in the event of an epidemic or pandemic. The District will only create this requirement when at least one vaccine becomes fully approved by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA). When one vaccine receives full FDA approval, the District will then accept any other vaccine that has FDA Emergency Authorization Use (EAU) approval. Vaccine requirements are subject to relevant state and federal laws.
