Chapter 2 – Governing Board

BP 2010 Governing Board Membership

References:

Education Code Sections 72023, 72103, and 72104;
2024 ACCJC Accreditation Standard 4 and Eligibility Requirement 7

The purpose of the Governing Board of the Palomar Community College District is to serve as a representative body elected by and responsible to the people of the College District. The Governing Board shall consist of five members elected by the qualified voters of the District. Members shall be elected by trustee area as defined in BP 2100 Board Elections.

Any person who meets the criteria contained in law is eligible to be elected or appointed to serve as a member of the Governing Board.

No member of the Governing Board shall, during the term for which they were elected, be eligible to serve on a governing board of a high school district whose boundaries are coterminous with those of the community college district.

An employee of the District may not be sworn into office as an elected or appointed member of the Governing Board unless they resign as an employee.

No member of the Governing Board shall, during the term for which they are elected, hold an incompatible office.
