BP 3501 Campus Security and Access

The institution provides safe and effective physical resources at all locations where it offers instruction, student services, and learning supports.

The Superintendent/President shall establish procedures for security and access to District facilities.

The Superintendent/President shall establish a participatory governance committee tasked with examining the safety and security of District facilities including but not limited to:

- General security of District facilities
- Hazardous materials
- Dangerous equipment
- Laboratory safety

The Governing Board has established a police department under the supervision of one Chief of Police, who shall report directly to the Superintendent/President or designee.

The purpose of the department is to enforce the law on or near the campus and other grounds or properties owned, operated, controlled, or administered by the District or by the state acting on behalf of the District.
