## **Equivalent Minimum Qualifications for Educational Administrator Classifications**

The following minimum qualifications for the classifications indicated below are ratified by the Governing Board as at least equivalent to the required minimum qualifications for educational administrators established by the California Code of Regulations, Title 5, § 53420; such equivalency is established pursuant to the California Code of Regulations, Title 5, § 53430.

## **Classification: Police Academy Director**

- Minimum qualifications required pursuant to Title 5, § 53420:
  - a) Possession of a master's degree; and
  - b) One year of formal training, internship, or leadership experience reasonably related to the administrator's administrative assignment.
- Alternative minimum qualifications ratified by the Governing Board for this classification in accordance with Title 5, § 53430:
  - a) A bachelor's degree in administration of justice or a closely related field <u>and</u> six years of full-time equivalent professional law enforcement experience <u>and</u> a California Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) Management Certificate, <u>or</u>
  - b) An associate's degree in administration of justice or a closely related field <u>and</u> nine years of full-time equivalent professional law enforcement experience <u>and</u> a California Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) Management Certificate.

## Classification: Police Academy Coordinator

- Minimum qualifications required pursuant to Title 5, § 53420:
  - a) Possession of a master's degree; and
  - b) One year of formal training, internship, or leadership experience reasonably related to the administrator's administrative assignment.
- Alternative minimum qualifications ratified by the Governing Board for this classification in accordance with Title 5, § 53430:
  - a) A bachelor's degree in administration of justice or a closely related field <u>and</u> six years of full-time equivalent professional law enforcement experience <u>and</u> a California Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) Advanced Certificate, or
  - b) An associate's degree in administration of justice or a closely related field <u>and</u> nine years of full-time equivalent professional law enforcement experience <u>and</u> a California Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) Advanced Certificate.
