### **NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

**The Governing Board of the Palomar Community College District** will hold a Board meeting on **March 14, 2017, at 5:00 p.m.**, at the Student Services Center, Governing Board Room (SSC-1) in the San Marcos campus, 1140 West Mission Road, San Marcos, CA, to consider modifications to the previously approved **North Education Center** (“Project”) located on a property in the northern part of the District near the community of Fallbrook, San Diego County, California. The Project changes include providing mitigation for Project impacts to wetland/riparian habitats completely on-site rather than the previously-approved combination of on- and off-site mitigation, along with additional on-site upland restoration and upland enhancement. The Governing Board will consider modifications to the North Education Center Project and an addendum to the previously certified Final Environmental Impact Report for the North Education Center under the State California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines Section 15164(a).
