





MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") is entered by and between the PALOMAR COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT ("District") and the PALOMAR FACULTY FEDERATION ("PFF") and is with respect Appendix B - Workload Schedule.

The parties agree that for the Spring 2017 semester only, the Workload Schedule for the two full-time instructors who teach Cabinet and Furniture Technology shall remain at the current eighteen (18)-hour lecture/lab load assignment. Commencing with the Fall 2017 semester and thereafter, all the full-time instructors in the Trade and Industry Department will convert to the standard fifteen (15)-hour lecture/lab load assignment.
