SUBJECT:

Life Insurance

In March 1992, the Governing Board approved an increase in the life insurance benefit level from \$60,000 to \$80,000. The Internal Revenue Service code states that the value of benefits above \$50,000 must be reported on your W-2 as taxable income.

The "value" is determined by using an IRS table, which is indexed for an individual's age. Using this table, payroll will figure the value of this coverage and add it to your taxable gross wages each month. An example of how this affects individuals at different ages is provided below.

If you are concerned about paying taxes on the value of the excess life insurance (\$30,000), you may designate a charitable organization as beneficiary for either the full benefit amount (\$80,000) or the taxable amount (\$30,000). The full life insurance value would then be exempt from taxed. Qualified organizations include charities such as those identified in the United Way campaign, non-profit, scientific, or religious organizations as well as non-profit educational institutions and their foundation (such as The Palomar College Foundation).

If you wish to designate a non-profit organization for all of your benefit, you may do so on your initial enrollment form. Please make sure that you identify the organization as non-profit.
