The Nursing program is working to implement a separate RN track for LVN's entering the program in their second year. In order to begin implementing this change, the Nursing Department needs a temporary increase in the class caps for NURS 217 and NURS 218 from 36 to 40 students until the new program track has been approved and is ready to begin enrolling students. This class cap change for these two courses would only be effective for the Fall 2018 and Spring 2019 semesters, returning to a cap of 36 for Fall 2019.
