Welcome to our PALOMAR*POWERED* Professional Development Program (3PD)!

What is Professional Development?

Professional Development is about learning and building your personal and professional skills. We have had a PD program for a very long time, but up until Fall of 2017 it was primarily for our Faculty, now it is for all of our employees. Our Board Policy 7160 states, "It is the intent of the District to support professional development opportunities for its employees. All eligible employees will be afforded opportunities and encouraged to participate in professional development/professional growth activities. The details regarding professional development/professional growth are delineated in the applicable collective bargaining agreement or employee handbook."

FT Faculty are required to complete Professional Development hours, PT Faculty are eligible for extra compensation for completing PD hours, Staff/Admin do not have a requirement and are not paid extra for PD. Faculty, please review <u>Article 10 of the PFF contract</u> for PD requirement/eligibility.

What is available for Professional Development?

We begin each semester with an all-college plenary. Fall plenary is a 2-day event the Thursday and Friday before the semester begins and in the Spring it is a 1-day event the Thursday before the semester begins. At plenary we have numerous workshops, meetings, and a general session to hear from campus leadership. To see what workshops are offered at a specific date and time please click on the "Workshop Calendar".

To search for online courses click on "Learner Home".



Want to quickly see how many total hours you have completed and print a transcript showing all of your completed hours?

Go to Reports and then Dashboards.



In the upper right corner of each graph you will see a dropdown arrow. Be sure to first REFRESH the graph and then you can print your transcript by clicking on "view details."
