II. Staffing Plan Orientation

Shawna Cohen presented a brief overview of the Staffing Master Plan 2016: Year 4 Update. She explained the purpose of the plan is to systematically identify and prioritize District staffing needs. Staffing needs are data-driven and identified by the planning councils and Superintendent/President's Group. The plan is tied to accreditation and various planning mechanisms.

SPC:

EEO:

- Vice President Tortarolo and several HRS staff members attended the annual Fall ACHRO/EEO Training Institute which took place in Newport Beach during mid-October.
- The Chancellor's Office sent a notification on 9/23/13 that the Department of Finance (DOF) signed off on the revisions of the title 5 regulations pertaining to equal employment opportunity in recruiting and hiring. The regulations have been filed with the Secretary of State and will become effective on October 19, 2013.

Professional Growth:

A new responsibility of the District will be to offer staff training on various computer programs. The new training will be coming soon.
