## **CLASSES USING PCTV VIDEO SERIES**

When scheduling a video class, the video series title must be included in the class notes. Closed Captioned classes must also be noted.

THE NUMBER OF VIDEO LESSONS PLUS THE NUMBER OF SEMINAR HOURS SHOULD EQUAL THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF HOURS REQUIRED FOR THE CLASS.

EXAMPLE: 3 UNITS = 54 hours; 30 videos + 24 seminar hours = 54

A 30-minute video is equivalent to a 50-minute lecture.

The number of seminars and the length of the seminar hours may be changed as long as the number of video lessons and the total number of seminar hours equal the maximum required number of hours for the class.
