The \$250 award will be distributed after the start date of the Fall 2017 semester. This scholarship is not renewable. Scholarship recipients will be chosen based on their academic records, personal essays, and any other relevant documents.

Requirements:

- Must be an F-1 student with I-20 issued by Palomar College for the Fall 16 or the Spring 17 semester
- Must be enrolled full-time for the Fall 2017 semester
- Must have a minimum overall GPA of 3.0 (as stated on the Work-in-Progress form)
- Students who started their studies at Palomar College in the Spring 2017 semester must submit a Work-in-Progress form
- Submit the application, your personal essay, and any other relevant documents to the Office of International Education (SU-103) no later than **Monday, April 24 at 3:00pm.**

Instructions:

- Demonstrate your eligibility for the scholarship in the **Personal Statement** (on page 2 of the application)

- We strongly recommend that you take your time completing your application.
- Make sure you answer all the questions.
- Incomplete applications will not be accepted.
- You must type all the information. Hand written applications will not be accepted.
