Road Rules

- 1. Seatbelt: Required for DRIVERS and ALL PASSENGERS
- 2. Right Turn on Red: Not with exception signs
- 3. **School Buses**: Stop when the bus's red lights flashing
- 4. **Bicycle Lanes**: Bicyclist must follow the same rule as automobile (Ride on the right side of the road)
- 5. **Pedestrians**: Must stop when pedestrians enter crosswalks
