Palomar College Instruction Modalities and F-1 Rules

Palomar College has more than 120 academic programs of study. The classes offered can change each academic year, which consists of 2 main semesters (fall and spring) and 1 summer semester. Instruction is provided in a variety of formats (in-person, online, and hybrid).

As an F-1 visa student at Palomar College, you agree to the following enrollment requirements:

- Enroll and complete at least 12 units you each semester (fall and spring). 9 of the 12 units must have weekly in-person, face-to-face classes.
- You are expected to take most in-person classes at the main San Marcos main campus.
- Palomar College does not guarantee in-person classes in all majors each semester. You may have to take class(es) that are outside your major to keep your F-1 status.
- Maintain a 2.0 GPA to show academic progress.
- New students arriving for summer term are required to enroll and complete at least 6 units inperson.
- Palomar College does not allow students outside the state of California to enroll in online classes. (Students who travel to another state or another country cannot take online classes).
