

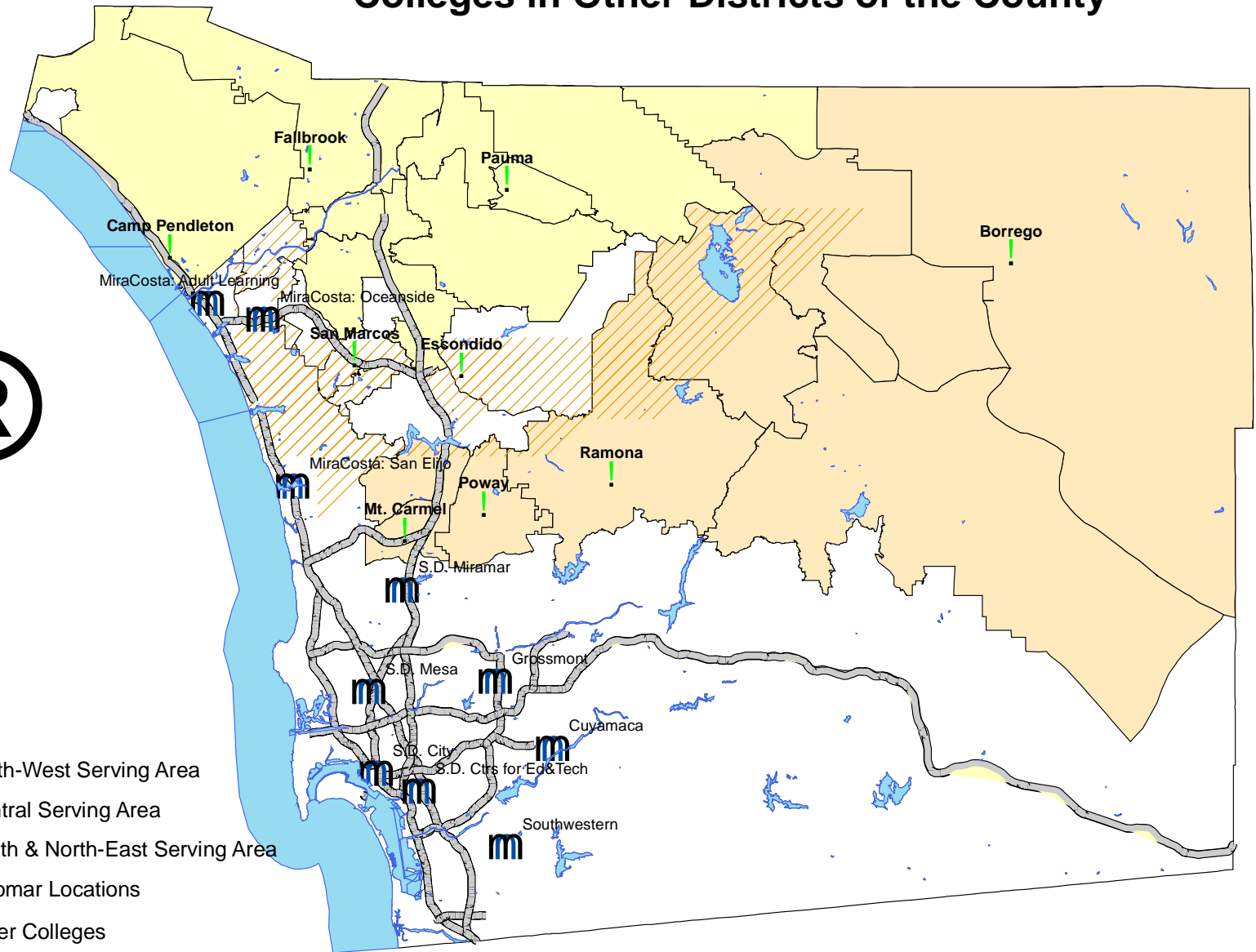

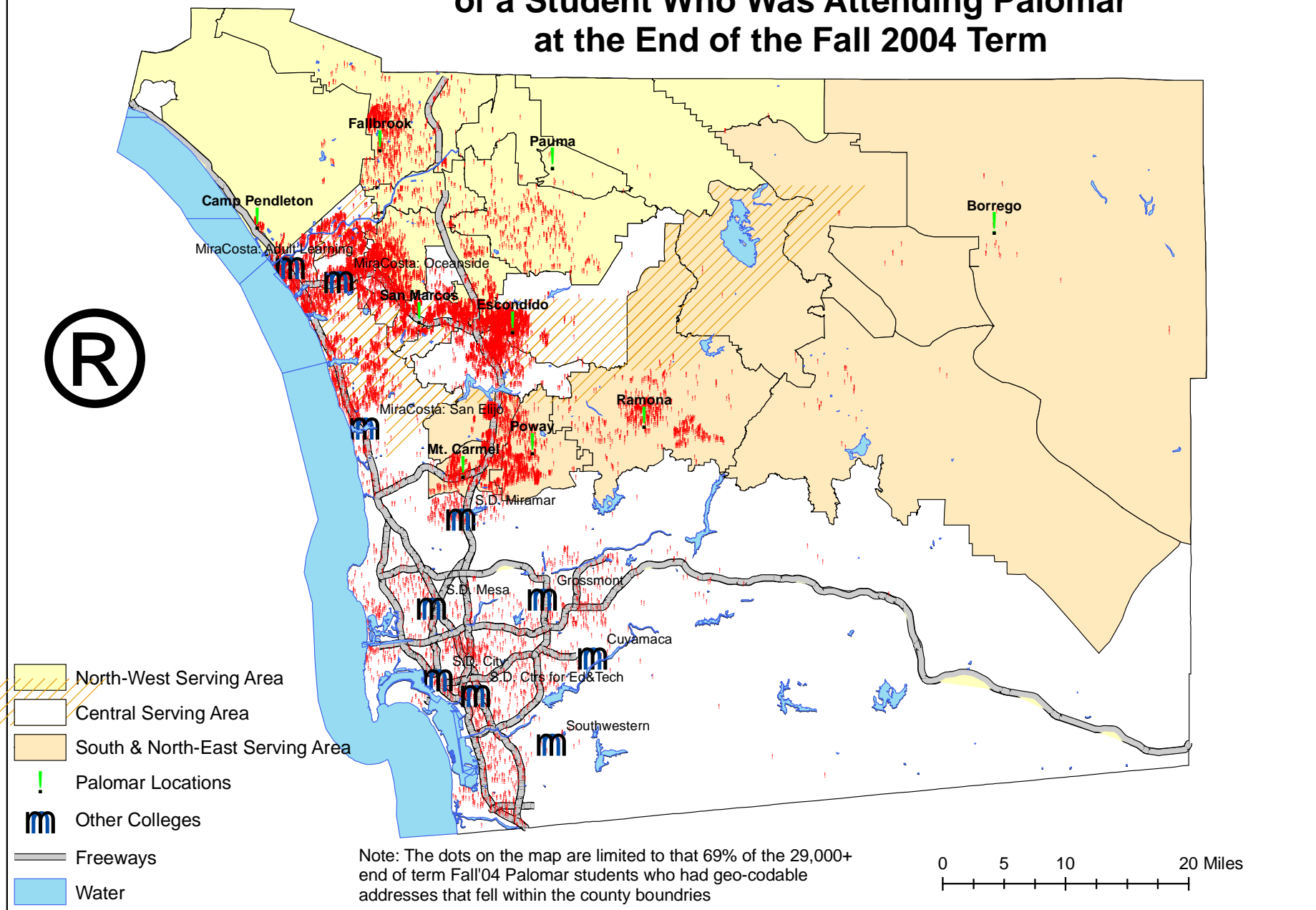

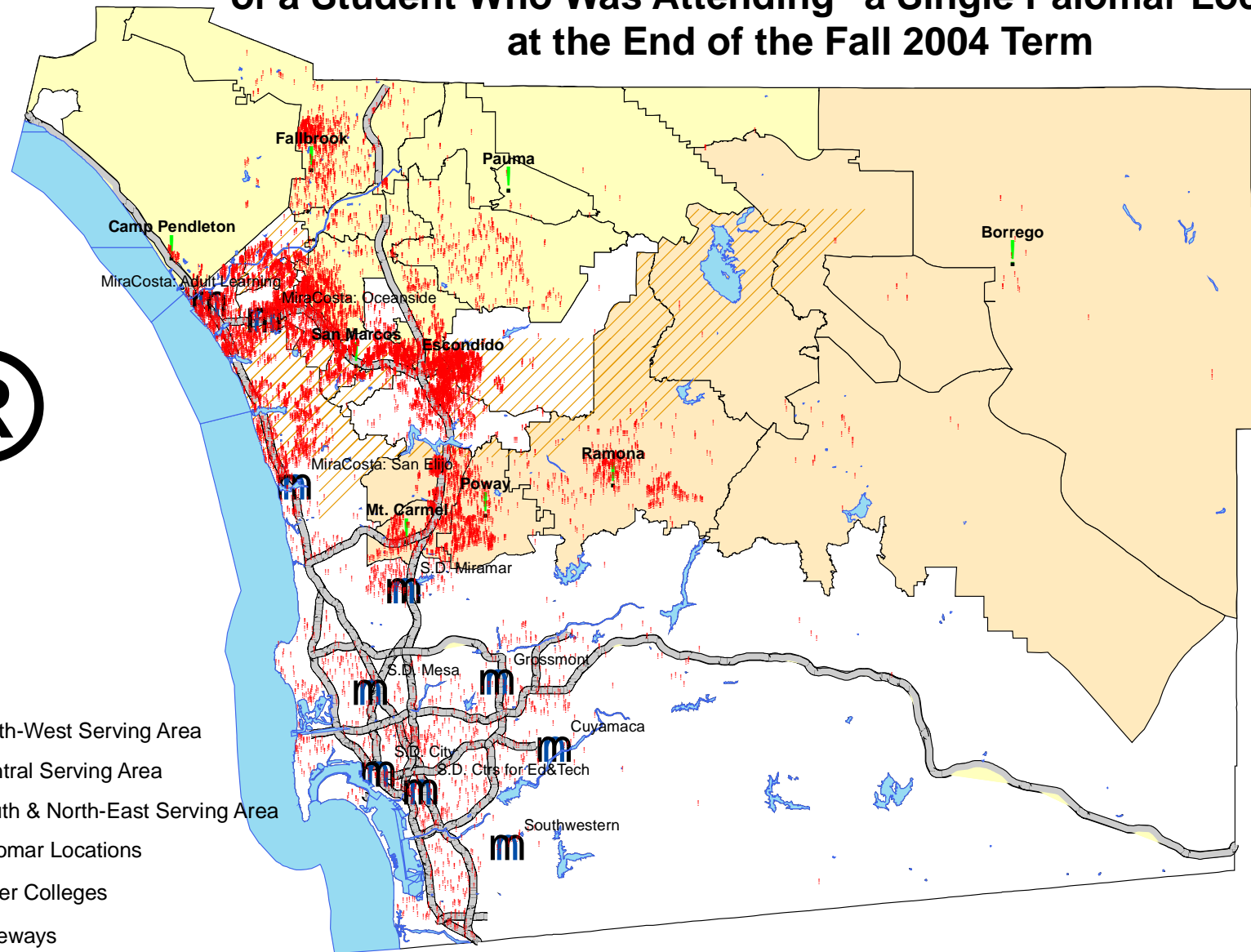

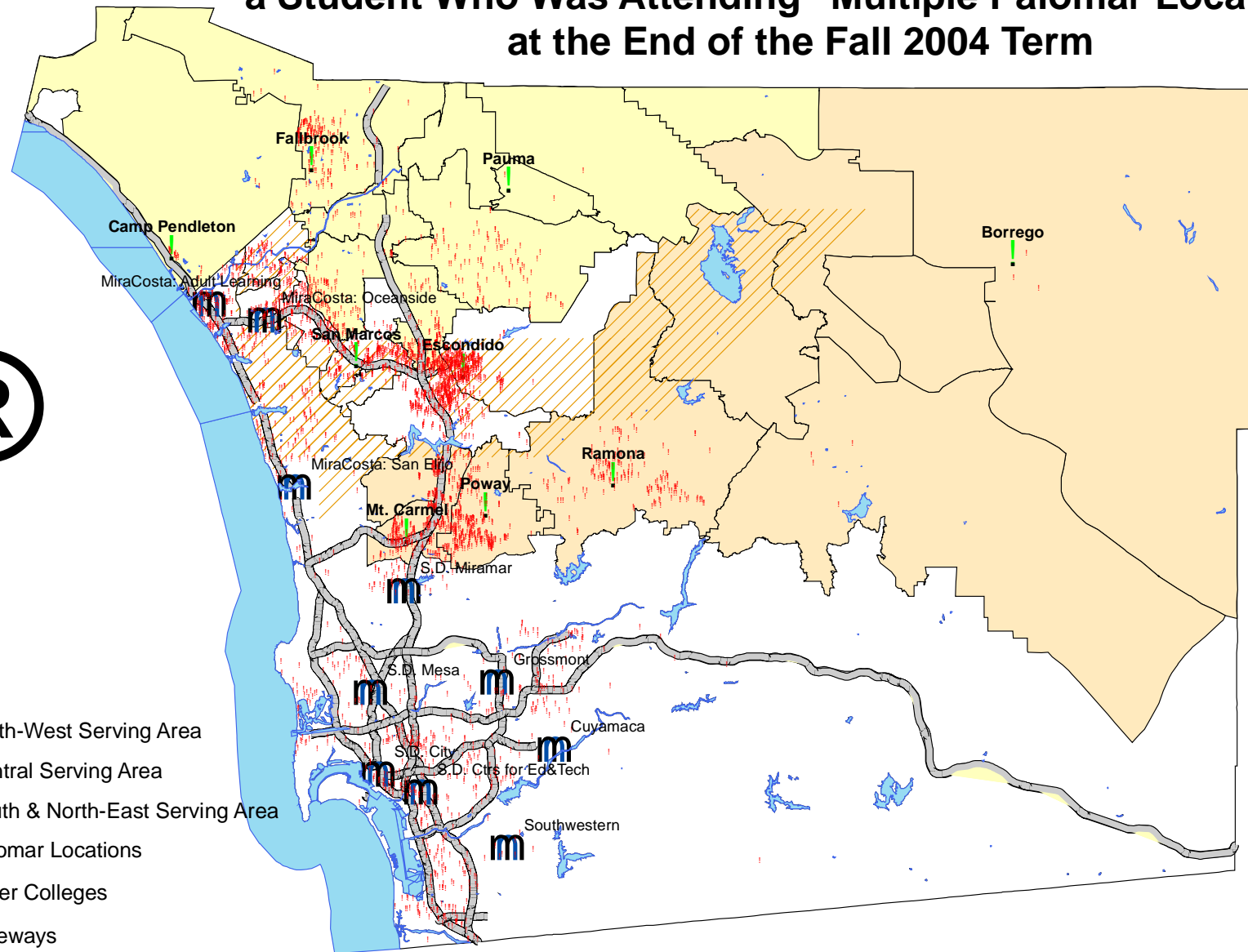


# Each Dot on the Map Represents the Residence Address of a Student Who Was Attending "Multiple Palomar Locations" at the End of the Fall 2004 Term
