Once you have become familiar with your new phone, the following step is to set-up your new voicemail box.



Always press the # key after recording any prompt or message. If the # key is not pressed the system will record dead air as part of your message.

Setting up your voicemail is as easy as 1, 2, 3:



1. Press the **tape icon/message** button located on your phone. Please note: If your extension does not appear on the phone, see page 2.
2. Enter your **PIN**. First-time users will enter the default PIN, **159357**.
3. Follow the system prompts to
 - a. record your name
 - b. record your personal greeting
 - c. change your password

Message quick-tips:

- To listen to messages, press **1**
- To save messages, press **2**
- To delete messages, press **3**

Additional voicemail information

To access voicemail from home, virtual voicemail accounts such as 5### accounts, or a voicemail account not programmed into the phone you are using, see below.

On Campus:

1. Dial extension **7112**.
2. Enter your **extension** followed by **#**, when prompted for your **ID**.
3. Enter your voicemail **PIN** followed by **#**, when prompted.

Off Campus:

1. Dial **760-891-7112**.
2. Enter your **extension** followed by **#**, when prompted for your **ID**.
3. Enter your voicemail **PIN** followed by **#**, when prompted.

*Please note, if this is your first time setting up your voicemail, use the default PIN **159357**.

To change your greeting, log into your voicemail and enter "4**" to enter the **setup options**, followed by "**1**" for the greeting.
