## Step 1

A. Download the Google Authenticator app to your mobile device. If you already have the Google Authenticator app on your mobile device and prefer to use it, please follow the directions below.

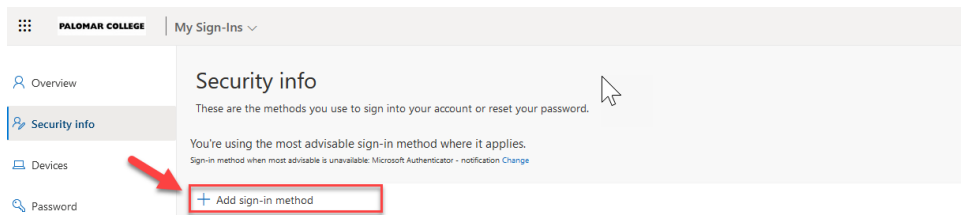

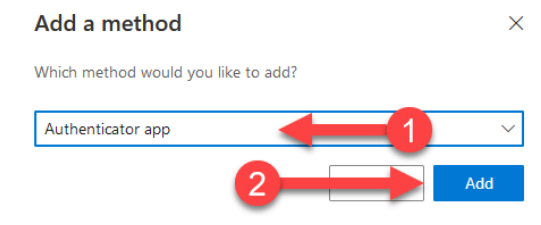
## Step 2

A. On your desktop, visit <https://aka.ms/mysecurityinfo>

B. Click **“Add sign-in Method”**

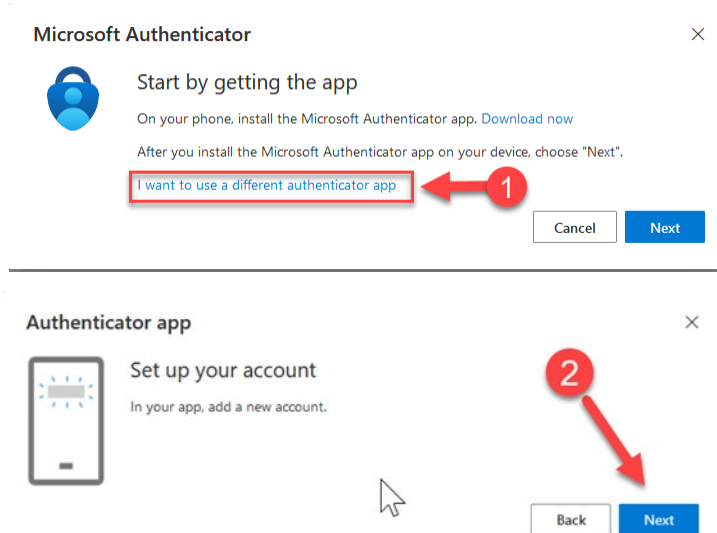


C. In the pop-up window, select **“Authenticator App”**, then click **“Add.”**



# Step 3

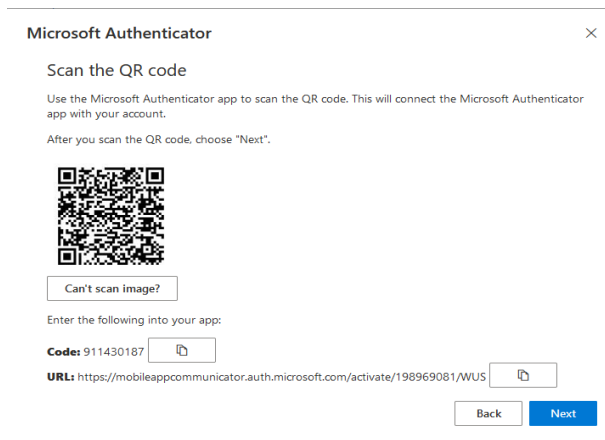
A. In the next pop-up, click on **"I want to use a different authenticator app"**, and then click **Next**.



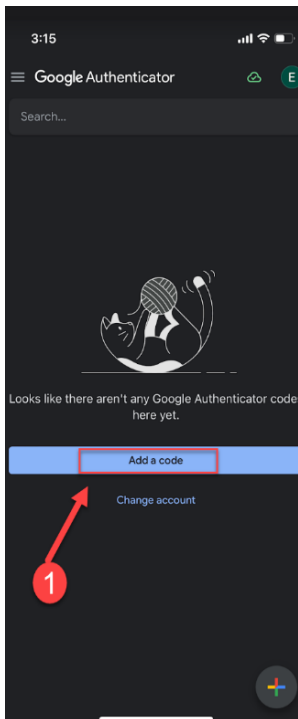
# Step 4

Follow the instructions on the website.

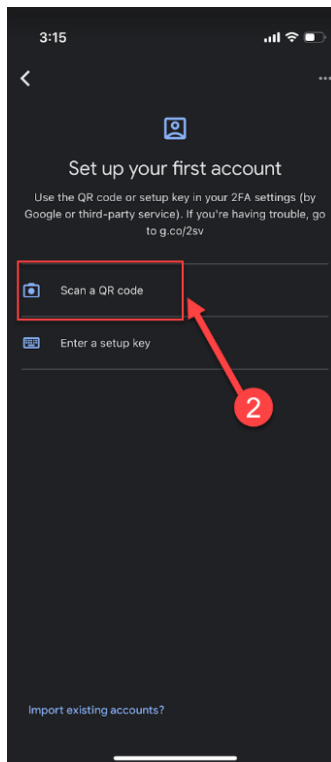
A. You'll be presented with a special QR code on the PC.



B. Open the Google Authenticator app on your phone and tap **“Add a code”**



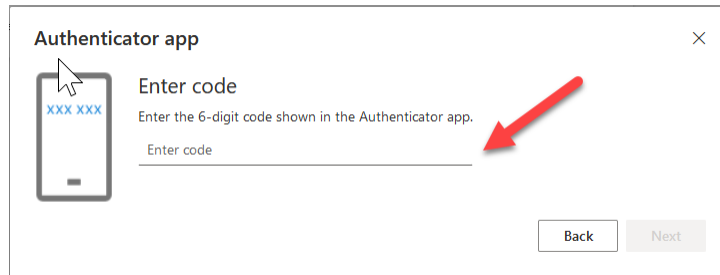
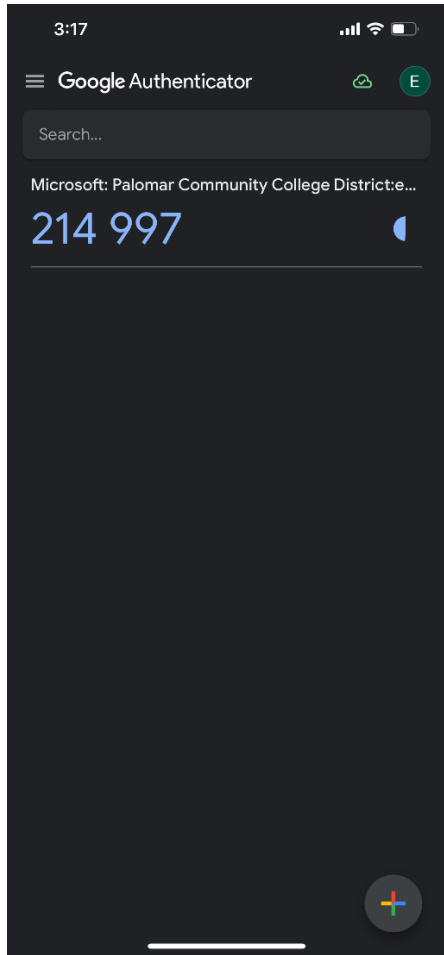
C. Select Use QR Code, scan the QR code that shows up on the PC.

A. Enter the code display on your authentication app.
