



Instructions for enabling 'WiFi-Calling' on your cell phone

To ensure improved call reception while inside a Palomar College building, you can enable WiFi calling on your personal cell phone. Here's how you can do this, understanding that the specific steps may vary by manufacturer.

General Steps to Enable WiFi Calling

1. Open Phone Settings:

- Go to your phone's **Settings** app.
