Application Checklist



The following documentation is REQUIRED to submit a nursing application:

- Palomar College Nursing Application Sheet
- Proof of high school graduation, GED certificate, or higher degree earned
  - Submit one of the following:
    - Copy of high school diploma or transcripts
    - Copy of GED certificate
    - Copy of higher degree (Associates, Bachelors, or Masters) or unofficial transcripts (from US accredited institution)
- Unofficial transcripts for prerequisite courses
  - Anatomy, Physiology, Microbiology
  - Math (intermediate algebra or higher), English Composition, Public Speaking/Speech, Psychology, Sociology, Humanities
- Copy of ATI TEAS score
  - If exam has been taken more than once, please submit copies of all exam scores
  - Include remediation verification, if applicable

The following documentation can be submitted for additional application points:

- Academic degree
  - Copy of degree certificate or unofficial transcripts indicating degree earned/conferred
- Allied Health Certification
  - Copy of certificate or license
- LVN license
  - Copy of license
- Relevant work or volunteer experience in healthcare (within the past 3 years, minimum of 100 hours)
- Veteran status (or spouse of veteran)
  - Copy of DD214 or military ID
- Disability
  - Copy of DRC evaluation letter, DSPS evaluation, VA evaluation, letter from physician
- Low family income
  - Copy of eligibility for financial aid, CCPG, Pell Grant, EOPS, EDD, Cal Fresh, Medi-Cal
- First generation of family to attend college
  - Written statement by applicant, about 100 words
- Need to work while completing prerequisites
  - Copy of letter signed by employer on company letterhead, pay stubs, or W-2s
- Social or educational disadvantages
  - Written statement by applicant, about 200 words
- Difficult personal or family circumstances
  - Written statement by applicant, about 200 words
- Refugee status
  - Copy of the card indicating refugee status
- Proficiency in language other than English
  - Submit one of the following:
    - Copy of high school transcripts
    - Copy of unofficial college transcripts
    - Letter from employer verifying proficiency
    - Written statement by applicant, about 200 words, translated into English
