 - Copy of higher degree (Associates, Bachelors, or Masters) or unofficial transcripts (from US accredited institution)

Unofficial transcripts for prerequisite courses

- Anatomy, Physiology, Microbiology
- Math (intermediate algebra or higher), English Composition, Public Speaking/Speech, Psychology, Sociology, Humanities
- Copy of ATI TEAS score
 - o If exam has been taken more than once, please submit copies of all exam scores
 - Include remediation verification, if applicable

The following documentation can be submitted for additional application points:

Academic degree

- Copy of degree certificate or unofficial transcripts indicating degree earned/conferred
- Allied Health Certification
 - Copy of certificate or license
- LVN license
 - Copy of license

Relevant work or volunteer experience in healthcare (within the past 3 years, minimum of 100 hours)

- □ Veteran status (or spouse of veteran)
 - Copy of DD214 or military ID

Disability

- Copy of DRC evaluation letter, DSPS evaluation, VA evaluation, letter from physician
- Low family income
 - Copy of awarded financial aid (ex. CCPG, Pell Grant)
- First generation of family to attend college
 - o Written statement by applicant, 100 words minimum
- □ Need to work while completing prerequisites
 - Copy of letter signed by employer on company letterhead or pay stubs
- Social or educational disadvantages
 - Written statement by applicant, 200 words minimum
- Difficult personal or family circumstances
 - o Written statement by applicant, 200 words minimum
- Refugee status
 - Copy of the card indicating refugee status
- Proficiency in language other than English
 - Submit one of the following:
 - Copy of high school transcripts
 - Copy of unofficial college transcripts
 - Letter from employer verifying proficiency
 - Written statement by applicant, 200 words minimum, translated into English
