What is Palomar Promise:

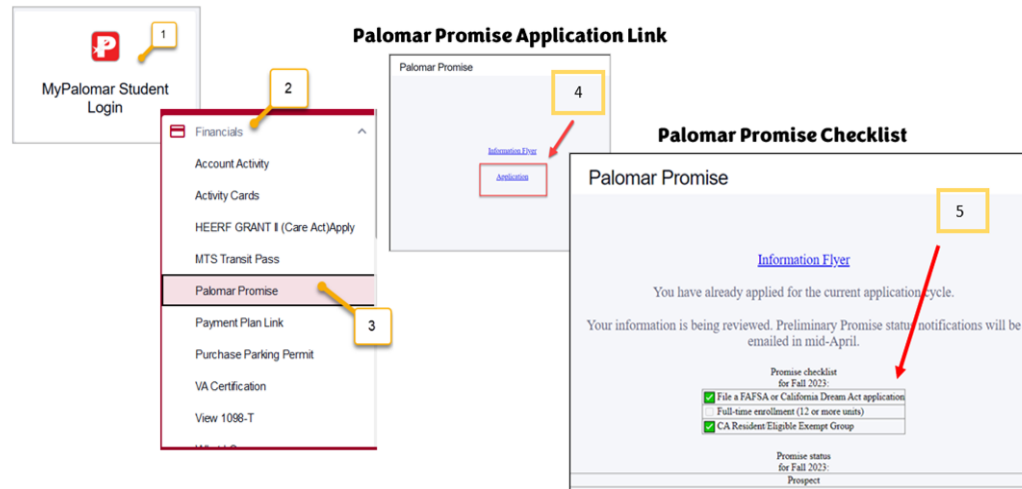
Promise offers up to two years of free tuition (fall & spring), textbook assistance, and specialized academic, career planning, and support services –

Regardless of family's income!

Requirements:

- File 2024-2025 FAFSA or Dream Act – **DO NOT NEED TO QUALIFY!**
- California resident or eligible exempt group (AB540 or military)
- 12 units each semester (possible DRC exemptions)
- 2.0 GPA

- Palomar annual **Scholarship season** opens beginning of January and ends early March.



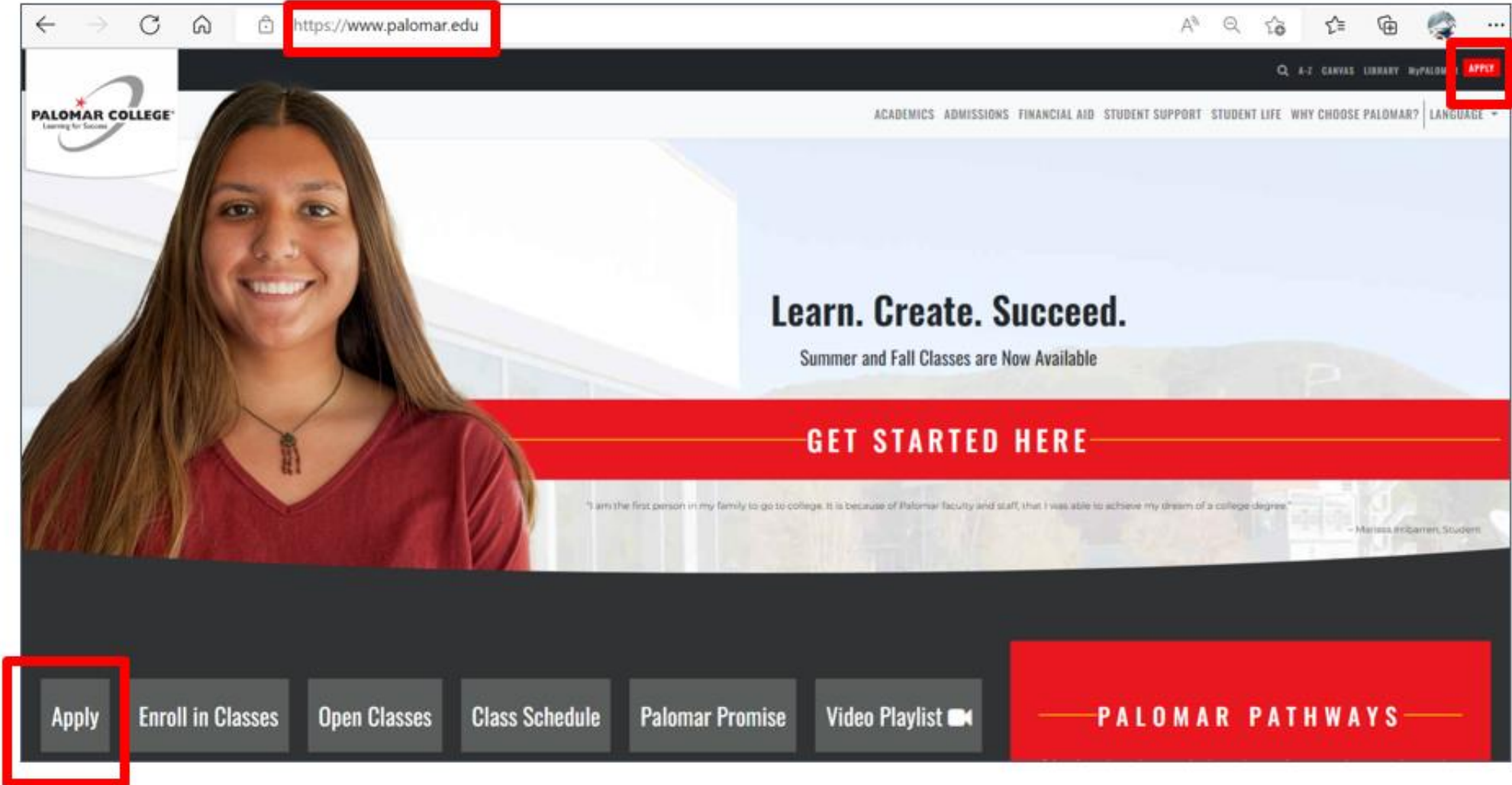
