Kahn Ph.D. Interim Superintendent / President, Palomar College Updated info on Covid-19 at PC: Anticipate 25% F2F enrollment for Fall 2021; working with Poway, Vista, and Escondido middle schools on a project called Middle College; strengthening migrant education / ESL / Tutoring programs; partnering with National University, SDSU and CSU-SM; 15% discount on tuition for RB Center in Fall.			
	<b>Budget:</b> in the black; 4-year plan to fund OPED retirement fund. <b>FCMAT:</b> based on funding from 2018; new funding formula through 2024 will hurt; Governing Board supports 13 action items—advisories all over the place; looking to 2025 for Basic Aid funding like Mira Costa College.			
	Antiracism: 9 goals  Discussion: on-campus rooms designated for hybrid meetings; GB will plan for Fall 2021 hybrid meetings. Pursuing student-centered funding based on cost of living.			
	Stacy Rungaitis, PC Director of Development/Executive Dir of the Foundation  Discussed the \$14 million in the endowment fund and updated members on Foundation activities; thanked PACRA for its donations to the Foundation on behalf of students. Pauline Riley, Accountant for the Foundation, will be retiring this year. George Boggs commented that PC is 75 years old this year, 2021, and suggested another time capsule be created.
