

If you have not received adjusted benefit, retroactive payment or been denied spousal or survivor benefits, do the following:

Request for Reconsideration

Deadline: File within **60 days** of the denial notice.

What to Do: Submit Form SSA-561 or request online/by mail.

What Happens: A new SSA reviewer will re-examine your case, including any new evidence you

provide.

For Spousal Benefit -Use Code B – Wife, age 62 or over, B1 – Husband, age 62 or over, B6 – Divorced

wife, age 62 or over

For Survivor Benefit -Use Code RSI - Retirement Survivor Benefit for a dead spouse

There are many other codes for marital status based on who is claiming the benefits. Divorced wives and husbands can receive spousal and survivor benefits.

File a Reconsideration Request

Complete Form SSA-561.

Say you're appealing because **retroactive spousal or survivor benefits from January 2024** were not paid.

Submit within **60 days** of the decision.

Refer to H.R. 82

State that **H.R. 82** repealed the GPO/WEP rules and made survivor benefits **retroactive to January 2024**.

Have original documents available – See Know Before You Go list

Contact SSA

Call **1-800-772-1213** or visit your local SSA office.

Ask if they received your appeal and if anything else is needed.

Contact your congressman and request an inquiry. They will email you a permission form.
