If a verb ends in <mark>–e</mark> , leave out e before <mark>– ing</mark>			
Smoke / smok ing hope / hop ing dance / danc ing confuse / confus ing			
Exceptions: be / being			
Verbs ending in -ee: see / s eeing agr ee / agr eeing			
If a verb ends in -e , add -d for the past (of regular verbs):			
Smoke / smok ed hope / hop ed dance / danc ed confuse / confus ed			
Adjectives and adverbs			
If an adjective ends in -e , keep the e before the adverb ending -ly			
polite / polit ely extreme / extrem ely absolute / absolut ely sincere / sincere ely			
If an adjective ends in -le (terrible, probable, etc) , leave out the e and add $-\mathbf{y}$ for the adverb.			
terrible / terrib ly probable / probab ly reasonable / reasonab ly
