Would you like additional language-based instruction and support while you work on your degree?

Take transferable ESL courses and complete your degree requirements in Humanities and Composition!

These advanced ESL courses have units that count towards your Associate degree and also transfer to the University of California and California State University systems:

ESL 106 Accelerated Written Communication II [6 Units]

An ESL Humanities course with practice in reading and writing academic English.

Critically analyze and respond to materials from culturally diverse traditions.

Learn about writing as a process, essay organization, rhetorical strategies, research strategies, synthesis of sources to support a writing topic, and critical reading.

This course transfers to the UC system as 3B [Humanities] and transfers to the CSU system as C2 [Humanities].

ESL 110 College Composition for Non-native Speakers [4 Units]

An ESL transferable composition course (which meets the same requirements as English 100). Learn about critical reading, critical thinking, expository and argumentative writing, and library research techniques.


Write expository, personal, and argumentative essays as well as a research paper and other types of writing. This course transfers to the UC system as 1A [English Composition] and transfers to the CSU system as A2 [Written Communication].

Please note: The ESL guided self-placement process will help students determine which ESL courses they would like to take. Students may take one or more ESL classes prior to transfer-level composition if they choose. ESL 105, 106, and 110 are all Associate Degree applicable as well as transferable. ESL 106 transfers to CSU/UC as Humanities units, and ESL 105 transfers as elective units. ESL 110 transfers to CSU/UC as transfer-level composition like English 100.

Other non-credit courses for beginning level students are available, as well as ESL courses for students interested in pronunciation, grammar, conversation, career skills, computer skills, etc.
