Why Participate?

- Meet staff, counselors and administrators from across campus to learn about the various resources and support programs available to you as a Palomar College student.
- Palomar Promise students are <u>required</u> to attend Skillshops during their fall and spring semester in order to maintain their Promise eligibility. Participation in the Promise Virtual Welcome Day will count towards your required Skillshop (must sign up and attend at least 3 Welcome Day sessions in order to count towards your fall Skillshop requirement).
- Attending Welcome Days is essential for all new Palomar Promise students to learn how they can thrive at Palomar College during this significant transition.

What if I can't attend because I have to work?

Although we highly encourage all incoming Promise students to attend, we understand some students may be unable to join us due to work obligations. The Virtual Promise Welcome Day website will remain live after August 13 and the live presentations/workshops will be available as recorded sessions to view.

How will these sessions be offered?

- All live sessions will be offered via ZOOM.
- Some sessions are pre-recorded and are accessible online via the Promise Welcome Day website. You can view these recordings now!

How do I register?

- Review the Welcome Day agenda online at https://www2.palomar.edu/pages/palomarpromise/welcome-day-highlights/ and then find the sessions you plan to attend.
- Click on the "Register for this Session" button next to the workshop description.
- Fill out the pre-registration form and submit. Within a couple of minutes, you will receive a confirmation email with the Zoom meeting details and link to join the workshop via Zoom.
- To help you organize your schedule, we encourage you to add all the Zoom events to your calendar as you will need to access these links the day of the event.
- Please note each virtual workshop has its own Zoom URL, and you must register in advance to join.

How do I join the virtual Promise Welcome Day sessions using Zoom?

• All Virtual Welcome Day workshops will be held using Zoom.

You can join Zoom session in several ways:

- 1. Using the Zoom website.
- 2. Download the Zoom app to your desktop and join from the app.
- 3. Download the Zoom app from your mobile device and join from the app.
- When joining a Zoom meeting you will be given a URL and a Meeting ID.
- Prior to joining the virtual workshop, please first sign in to your own zoom account! This ensures you are authenticated and we know who you are.

Joining Zoom Sessions from the Web, from your Desktop App, from your phone App

From the Zoom app:

- 1. Open the **Zoom** app on your desktop, Start button, **Zoom** folder, start **Zoom**.
- 2. Click on Sign in.
- 3. Click on Join.
- 4. Enter the **Meeting** ID (this is displayed in the email invitation)

From the Web Browser:

- 1. Go to **Zoom.US**
- 2. Sign in To Your Account
- 3. Click on "Join A Meeting"
- 4. Enter your **Meeting** ID

From a Mobile Device App

- 1. Open the App on Your Device
- 2. Sign in to you APP
- 3. Click on "Join"
- 4. Enter your **Meeting** ID (you will find this number on your Zoom Confirmation email after registering)

Stay MUTED when not purposefully speaking to the group.




Use the CHAT to connect!
