APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The Campus Police Committee approved the February 15, 2023, as written.

DISCUSSION ITEM(S)- OLD BUSINESS

- 1. Chief Moore updates on Blue Phones: two blue phones are out of service at the Fallbrook Campus and one at the Escondido Campus. Facility continues to work on this issue.
- 2. Chief Moore updates on lot 5 being temporarily closed due to parking lights not working properly. Wayne Hooper comments that the sign that alerts students/staff has come off.
- 3. William "Skip" Clark shares that the fence for the Escondido Campus has been reapproved by the Governing Board. Chief Moore confirms that the fence got reapproved by the Department of State Architects and now goes out for bid.
- 4. Chief Moore updates on body cameras and is also looking into updating the tasers that the department currently has.
- 5. Thomas Daily confirms with GI Wilson about the DHS training scheduled for April 19, 2023. Chief Moore and GI Wilson extends the invitation to ASG and anyone outside the committee.
- 6. Chief Moore comments on two set positions for Dispatcher interviews to be set soon. Along with two Sergeant replacements and police officer interviews.
- 7. Chief Moore, Professor Wilson, Peppa Pierce and Officer Montes attended the Behavioral Health and Law Enforcement Community event on March 10, 2023.
- 8. Chief Moore attended the 12th Annual Women in Blue along with staff from the Police Department on March 8, 2023.
- 9. Chief Moore shares that a new police vehicle has been added to the department. This vehicle will assist with parking enforcement as soon as the license plate reader has been equipped.
- 10. Thomas Daily comments that performances have begun every weekend.

- 1. CHIEF MOORE: will be meeting with ASG on Friday, April 17, 2023, to share plans and answer questions.
