I. <u>CALL TO ORDER/INTRODUCTION</u>

Chairperson, Thomas Daily opens and will be facilitating the meeting.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The Campus Police Committee approved September 27, 2023, as written.

On a motion by GI Wilson, seconded by Yvette Maynard.

DISCUSSION ITEM(S)- OLD BUSINESS

- 1. Chief Moore addresses the cameras concerns-still in progress along with the blue phones.
- 2. Lisa Casas requesting information on the Escondido campus cameras.
- 3. Chief Moore understands that cameras are part of the construction being done at the Escondido campus.
- 4. Thomas Daily mentions that his department has been approved to install two cameras in the courtyard towards the practice rooms.
- 5. Dana Mendez Garcia requests information about the installation of cameras at the SU.
- 6. Chief Moore mentions there are no cameras. Will provide an update for next meeting.

DISCUSSION ITEM(S) - NEW BUSINESS

- 1. JILL D'ERRICO: shares concerns of communication towards a person with a Halloween custom disturbing staff. Requests an update of the incident.
- 2. CHIEF MOORE: incident occurred on October 13, 2023. There was a 10-minute delay in reporting the person in custom (hockey mask, with a plastic floppy knife, holding a pumpkin). TLC contacted Campus Police regarding the same person in custom. Both parties delayed reporting the incident.
- 3. JILL D'ERRICO: contacted dispatch for further information as well. Will notify why there was no emergency message sent out regarding this incident.
- 4. LISA CASAS: asks if there are any rules regarding Halloween customs worn on campus.
- 5. CHIEF MOORE: No specific rules, no weapons.
- 6. DANA MENDEZ GARCIA: notifies the committee that there will be a Halloween custom contest on October 31st at the SU quad from 10:00a.m.-1:00p.m.
- 7. CHIEF MOORE: hiring updated went out last week for three police officers.
- 8. YVETTE MAYNARD: asked if any officers will be assigned full time at the Fallbrook center.
- 9. CHIEF MOORE: will continue to work on having more consistency on scheduling for Escondido and Rancho Bernardo campuses. A Police Officer has been assigned for the Fallbrook center.
- 10. CHIEF MOORE: Outreach events with Pride group-Coffee with a Cop on October 11th. Trunk or Treat will be another event being hosted by Campus Police on October 25th by the LRC.
- 11. DANA MENDEZ GARCIA: suggests gathering for a Comet Hour with Campus Police for the month of November.
- 12. SINA LAIE: suggests connecting with the Truck or Treat event and Comet Hour event that will be hosted on the same day.
- 13. THOMAS DAILY: shares awareness of drug use during the performance days hosted on the weekends.
- 14. CHIEF MOORE: suggests requesting extra security on future events.
- 15. THOMAS DAILY: updates on fence (Escondido campus).
- 16. LISA CASAS: construction continues and understands that construction might be done by December 2023-January 2024. Reports that one of the ECE windows was vandalized during the weekend.
- 17. DANA MENDEZ GARCIA: asks if students need to show ID when entering campus once the pedestrian gates are closed.
- 18. CHIEF MOORE: gates will be open during school hours allowing students to access campus.
- 19. DAILY THOMAS: suggests adding a Permanent staff to the committee.
