I. <u>CALL TO ORDER/INTRODUCTION</u>

Advisor, Chief Chris Moore opens and will be facilitating the meeting.

DISCUSSION ITEM(S)- OLD BUSINESS

DISCUSSION ITEM(S) - NEW BUSINESS

- CHIEF MOORE: discusses incident that occurred at the Escondido Campus. Lisa Casas contacted
 facilities regarding the possible threat to campus. Officer Forest was dispatched to the call and the
 Escondido Police Department was involved as well. The incident was across the Escondido Campus
 (Taco Bell). Chief Moore will contact Tom Medel for further intel. Chief Moore assures having an
 officer at the Escondido Campus.
- 2. LISA CASAS: contacted facilities as soon as she noticed the subject and facilities notify the subject to leave campus.
- 3. CHIEF MOORE: participating in drills:
 - -Environmental Health and Safety-Shake Down drill (10/20/22) for earthquake preparedness. Will be using the InformaCast through the drill.
 - Lockdown drill for all campuses scheduled for next month.
 - -Testing the SMSX function of InformaCast: advises to check text/phone notifications regarding the drill's notifications.
- 4. THOMAS DAILY: asks when the lockdown drill will take place.
- 5. CHIEF MOORE: unsure of date: November 16th or the 17th
- 6. CHIEF MOORE: will following up with Thomas Daily regarding the discussion with CCE leadership (body worn cameras for officers).
- 7. CHIEF MOORE: officers toured One Safe Place and the services provided. Strangulations was discussed as being a high rate of homicide. A force that is also used against officers.
- 8. CHIEF MOORE: welcomes ASG representative
- 9. CHIEF MOORE: announces LGBTQIA Coffee with a COP event for November.
- 10. GUADALUPE SOTO GONZALEZ: presents another senator, Tafadzwa Madziva.
- 11. CHIEF MOORE: committee build to have student and faculty staff be part of and have a voice to speak out concerns.
- 12. WAYNE HOOPER: asks if the Emergency Phones have been addressed for the Escondido campus and two Blue Phones at the Fallbrook campus for out of service
- 13. CHIEF MOORE: will verify work orders for the phones with Officer Montes. Will follow up today about the Escondido campus Emergency phone.
- 14. MICHELLE FIFIELD: Due to importance of the positions and to maintain these positions can the Step placement be increased? Will the classification work include these positions?
- 15. CHIEF MOORE: HR is always pursuing by issuing forms that can be submitted.
- 16. CHIEF MOORE: discusses what a lockdown could be: active shooter, tanker on fire with toxic fuels, threat on campus (suitcases-bomb), leak on campus, shooting on the sprinter station.
- 17. LISA CASAS: what time will the lockdown take place?
- 18. CHIEF MOORE: probably early morning.
- 19. LISA CASAS: asks who to contact to request public safety presentations.
- 20. CHIEF MOORE: Officer Montes or Sgt. Lopez for any presentations
- 21. CHIEF MOORE: Officer Montes reported that the old station phone has an Out of Order signs. Will place a work order.
