- 1. THOMAS DAILY: Introduction of Committee. New members:

- 2. CHIEF MOORE: Updates the hiring of two female officers to the department done over the summer.
 - -Threat Assessment presented by GI Wilson on Plenary during week to Palomar staff. Will plan future presentations.
 - -Red Folder, resource guide for Behavioral Intervention, working on updating where the folder may be placed, physical document/digital document to share.
