- 8. CHIEF MOORE: AB481 Military Weapons published policy on the website, information item for Governing Board-report equipment usage. Involved in 35x30- increase the percent of female officers. Special guest Officer Nicole Davis.
- 9. OFFICER DAVIS: started working as of last summer 2024, previous with Oceanside Police Department for about 8 years, Mira Costa PD College as a dispatcher for 3.5 years, past year before Palomar, DOD Marine Corps-Domestic Violence Victim Advocate.
- 10. CHIEF MOORE: Both female officers have investigated experiences, they connect with One Safe Place, investigation of child crime.
- 11. OFFICE DAVIS: Detective at Oceanside PD, background involves domestic violence, sexual assault, Internet Crime against Children- 2 years, family protection experience.
- 12. WILLIAM "SKIP" CLARK: Escondido Campus Midway electronic gate allows to open during the weekend.
- 13. CHIEF MOORE: keypad resolved?
- 14. TOM MEDEL: does not think it's 100% operational, has not heard regarding the keypad
- 15. CHIEF MOORE: request Officer Davis to look into visibility of keypad during next Escondido campus visit. More outreach done regarding immigration and the role of police.
